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UK Deaf Sport Recognition Process





What do we mean by recognition ?

The Aim is to:

Clarify the accurate status or each Deaf Sport Organisation (DSO) in relation to the development of the sport





Why do we need to change ?

The process has been created to address the inconsistency in developmental capacity of existing National Deaf Sport Organisations to drive forward sports development programmes for the good of their sports

•To create a greater clarity of expectation of the different categories of organisation

•To enable UK Deaf Sport to identify support needs of Deaf Sports Organisations that will enable them to develop into the type of organisation that they want to be

•To create a fair and consistent approach to monitor whether sports bodies continue to meet the requirements of recognition

•To ensure that a credible bodies exist that are responsible for development of the sport from grassroots to Elite





Three Categories

- 1. National Deaf Sports Organisation
- 2. Sub National/Area/ Regional Deaf Sport Organisation
- 3. National Performance Squad





The process

- Discussion with UK Deaf Sport
- Prepare application portfolio of evidence against category criteria
- Submit to critical friend for comment
 - Submit for assessment by Recognition Panel
 - Recognition Panel make recommendation to the UK Deaf Sport Board
 - Decision

<u>Decisions</u>

- Approved
- Approved with some condition of future work needed and timescale
- Rejected with a full explanation of the reason and offer of support





<u>Timescale</u>

- 3 year process
- Consultation starts today
- Formal launch in April 2013
