Please read our Collection Box Guidelines below as there are regulations you will need to adhere to when you agree to host a collection box.

Collection Box Guidelines

- You must only use official UK Deaf Sport collection boxes.
- UK Deaf Sport must see written permission from your premises before we can send you a collection box¹.
- All collection boxes must be securely sealed with the seals provided by the charity. If you need any more, please let us know.
- ♣ All collection boxes must be returned within one month of their final use.
- If you believe a collection box has been stolen or interfered with, you must contact us immediately at info@ukds.org.uk and report it to your local police.
- When collecting money, you must not put undue pressure on people to donate. This includes shaking the collection boxes, or hassling people.
