



## DeaflympicsGB Athlete Eligibility Policy Tokyo 2025 Deaflympics

- 1. To represent Great Britain at the Deaflympics, athletes must be a British Citizen (with a valid British Passport).
- 2. Athletes can be from either England, Northern Ireland, Scotland or Wales.
- 3. A British Passport will be used to prove eligibility.
- 4. Athletes can change their desire to compete for Great Britain from another country only once. However, athletes will need to wait for two years\* between competitions.
- 5. Athletes may not return to the first county of representation after officially changing nationality.
- 6. Athlete's gender, race, religion or politics have no influence on eligibility to represent Great Britain.
- 7. Athletes should note, sports may have an age limit for competition at the Deaflympics.
- 8. All athletes must have a minimum 55dB hearing loss in the "better ear" as noted in the ICSD Audiogram Regulations.
- 9. Athletes must meet all the sport specific entry requirements as noted in the sport specific selection policies.
- 10.UK Deaf Sport will submit a Final Names Form with all the names of the athletes to ICSD for the DeaflympicsGB Team. ICSD will confirm eligibility to participate in the event.
