

Destination Deaflympics Research Prize Draw Terms

Terms and Conditions (the “Terms”)

These terms and conditions apply to the Destination Deaflympics Research Prize Draw (the “the Promotion”) taking place between 01 February **2025** and **31 December 2025**. The promoter is: UK Deaf Sport, c/o Kings Accountants, 4 Grovelands, Boundary Way, Hemel Hempstead, HP2 7TE Charity Number 1158878, (the “Promoter”).

1. The promotion is open to deaf schools, deaf resources bases, NDCS societies, community clubs or deaf sports clubs engaging with deaf young people aged 8–16 (or other organisations engaging with deaf young people) in the United Kingdom (England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland) and the Isle of Man or Channel Islands which have subscribed to the Destination Deaflympics programme and postal packs, excluding employees of the Promoter and their immediate families.
2. Entry to the Promotion is free.
3. Enter the Promotion by completing and returning the Destination Deaflympics pre and post surveys by 31 December 2025. The pre and post activity surveys are available on the Destination Deaflympics Google Drive shared folder and completed surveys should be returned via email to destinationdeaflympics@ukds.org.uk

4. The Promotion opens at 08:00 on 01 February 2025 and ends 23:59 on 31 December 2025. No entries will be accepted after this date. One winner will then be selected at random after this date.
5. The prize for the randomly selected winners is one of eighteen (18) £200 vouchers from Davies Sports.
6. The prize is non-transferable and non-exchangeable. However, in the event of unforeseen circumstances, the Promoter reserves the right to offer an alternative prize of equal value. Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Promoters the prize will only be awarded directly to the winners. Prizes cannot be sold or auctioned or otherwise transferred to a third party.
7. Selection of the winners will be made by the Promoter by 15 January 2026. The teacher / leader / education professional chosen as the winning party will be contacted by 30 January 2026 and asked to accept the prize. In the event that the Promoters are not able to contact the winner by 15 February 2026, an alternative winner will be drawn.

8. Delivery of the prize will be arranged within two weeks of the winner accepting the prize. The winners will be announced by 15 March 2026.

9. All data relating to non-winners will be deleted by 15 April 2026. Winners' details will be retained to enable the Promoter to deliver the prize, including carrying out due diligence. The data will be deleted once the prizes have been fulfilled, by 15 April 2026.

10. The Promoter reserves the right to change or cancel this Promotion at any stage and without prior notice, if it deems necessary, or if circumstances arise outside of its control.

11. The Promoter will not be liable for any failure of receipt of entries and takes no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, illegible, corrupted, damaged, incomplete or otherwise invalid.

12. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment incurred or suffered as a result of entering the Promotion or accepting the prize. Nothing shall exclude the liability of the Promoter for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.

13. By entering the Promotion, all entrants will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the Promotion rules and consent to the transfer of their personal data to the Promoter, for the purposes of the administration of this Promotion. All entry instructions form part of the rules.
