- Lead, develop and support the delivery of our fully accessible online activities through our #deafactiveonline programme. If and when restrictions are lifted, this role will look to set up face to face sport and physical activity opportunities in London
- Support and Develop the network of online trainers
- Work with partners to Identify and develop training opportunities to achieve good accessible activities offers from mainstream coaches and service providers.
- Work with partners and key charities to explore opportunities linked with delivering sport and mental health and wellbeing activities
- Work with internal staff and partners to ensure that all project activities are accessible and reflect the needs of Deaf and Hard of Hearing people from all communities, backgrounds and cultures.

You will have experience of working in a creative, person centric participation environment. The post holder will be responsible for leading on and working alongside our key partners Access Sport and Street Games to oversee and manage a wide range of activities. We are looking for someone who will strengthen and maintain accurate records which include supporting mid and year end reporting.
