





Overall aim

To support NGBs to get 900 Deaf people, participating, staying & excelling in sport.




Grow- 800 more Deaf (over 16) & 100 more Deaf children participating in sport

- Sustain specific project aimed at 16+ dropoff & 3,000 more coaches qualified to provide for Deaf people
- More Deaf people as officers, officials, volunteers in NGBs

Excel- Deaf athletes within mainstream sport (NGBs)

Development of a clear events strategy that clarifies the roles of NGBs and UKDS


