Withdrawal of 1 team in the Qualifications for European Championships : penalty

Proposal for football :

We would propose to implement the following measures to teams who are withdrawing in the Qualifications Round before the EC takes place. Example : in a group of 3 teams only 2 teams (A1 + A3) play their games, the 3rd team (A2) withdraw from competition.

A1 vs A2 (not played)

A2 vs A3 (not played)

A3 vs A1 (played)

A1 and A3 are qualified. A1 has spent travel and accommodation costs, A3 has almost no travel or accommodation costs.

Who will have to pay for the difference of costs ?

A3 can pay half of the costs to A1

or

A2 + A3 should reimburse each 25% of the costs to A1

or A2 will reimburse 50 % of the costs to A1 ?

Explanation: This proposal can also for other team sports.

PROPOSAL EDSO FUTSAL TOURNAMENT 2014

For information:

2002 - EDSO receive 17 men and 8 women teams preliminary entries
2006 - EDSO receive 22 men and 10 women teams preliminary entries
2010 - EDSO receive 27 men and 14 women teams preliminary entries
2014 - ??? 30 men and 16 women ???

EDSO will have every intention to ensure the Championship regulations are in parallel with UEFA / FIFA regulation.

For World Deaf Futsal Championship, will remain as per ICSD regulation, top 10 teams will qualify from European Championship.

PROPOSAL

Option 1

OPEN Application

This is the current system and schedule may not comply with UEFA Regulation, depending on the number of teams.

PRO (Positive)

Open tournament, more match opportunities and experience for lower teams

CON (Negative)

Standard of Futsal is low due to higher diversity in strength of team
High number of teams, caused complication to match schedule.
More players easily prone to injuries, due to heavy schedules of matches.
Not very cost effective for organisation.



PROPOSAL

Option 2

Limit to 16 teams for both sexes in Final Tournament

Add new mini tournament for men. Women is possible to have mini tournament, depending on the number of teams participation.

Mini Tournament will be place at the location of the Top 10 teams from the last European Championship 2010.

Mini Tournament will take place at 7 difference locations and will only take place at weekend (Friday - Sunday).

Mini Tournaments are to be taken place in between January and March 2014.

Each location will have at least 6 matches (4 matches on Saturday and 2 matches on Sunday).

Each location will have 4 teams and had to be geographically / economic location.

Top two teams from mini tournament shall qualify to the Final Tournament

Host of the Final Tournament and the 2010 European Champion are automatic qualify.

This system is very much the same as current UEFA Futsal Tournament

PRO (Positive)

Standard of Futsal will be higher, due to less diversity in between strength of team

Less number of teams, easier on match schedule. More rest in between matches

Less players usage

More cost effective for both organisation and participation teams

Good opportunities for lower teams and cheaper in term of travel cost if nearer to appropriate location and more competitive.

CON (Negative)

Mini Tournament may cost more for the top 8-10 teams if they are qualify to Final. Only if there is NO subsidy from UEFA.



DEAFLYMPIC QUALIFICATION DEAF FOOTBALL

The reason for this qualification based on the technical regulation and with the recent introduction of ICSD World Championship and separate qualification route for Deaflympic as agreed from ICSD Congress at Salt Lake City 2007. ICSD had handed their accountability to the regional confederation as agreed from ICSD Congress, Taiwan 2010.

This had caused many complications to the schedule and economic factors for the EDSO Affiliated members

PROPOSAL

Option 1

6 or 7 teams qualify from EDSO to Deaflympic

Automatic qualification from European Championship to World Championship and automatic of the European team from World Championship to Deaflympic.

This is the old system.

PRO (Positive)

Very low cost of expenditure

Prevent the team from withdrawing from World Championship

European Championship will not lose its platform for Deaflympic

CON (Negative)

Lack of competitive Football for lower team (No development)

Team will have to wait 4 years for the next competitions. (No opportunities)

Slow progress of standard in competitive football.

Option 2

6 or 7 teams qualify from EDSO to Deaflympic

Qualification in 2 stages,

All matches start in September (2015) until September in the following year (2016), no matches one month before World Championship 2016.

First stage will be play by new or lower teams, and two matches (2 teams) or round robin with 3 teams.

Second stage will be by top 6 or 7 seeded teams from EM against team qualify from first stage.

PRO (Positive)

More competitive football for new or lower teams.

No more waiting for 4 years

Improve standard of competitive football

CON (Negative)

More chance of team withdraw from World Championship



Definition of International Deaf Sports Federations, IDSF

An International Deaf Sports Federation, IDSF, Associated Member of the ICSD shall:

- Only accept National Member Federations which are members in good standing with the ICSD
- Abide to the Audiogram Regulations decided by the ICSD Congress
- Abide to the ICSD rules concerning use of hearing devices during competitions but can have own penalty regulations adopted for each sport
- Leave all doping questions to be handled by the ICSD

An International Deaf Sports Federation, IDSF, Associated Member of the ICSD will be:

The World Governing Body of only its own sport and be fully responsible with planning and arrangement of:

* World and Regional Championships in cooperation with the ICSD and its Confederations.

* Deaflympics tournaments and qualifications to these in cooperation with the ICSD and its Confederations

* Reports of

- Locations
- Period
- Results

of the tournaments to the ICSD and respective ICSD Confederations.

An International Deaf Sports Federation, IDSF, Associated Member of the ICSD has to:

- Regularly arrange own General Assembly (GA) with elections of President and Executive Board
- Regularly arrange meetings with the Executive Board
- Establish a firm and steady connection with International Sports Federation, hearing ISF, in its own sport with economic alternatively administrative support by the Federation in question

All the above points must be stated in the IDSF Constitution and Regulations and approved by the ICSD Executive Board.

A trial period of two (2) years for each new IDSF founded may be issued with a formal approval at the next upcoming ICSD Congress.

Each change of the Constitution and Regulations of the IDSF must thereafter be approved by the ICSD Executive Board.

(It is recommended that the ICSD Executive Board is working out a normal Constitution and Regulations text for the upcoming IDSF to be formed in the future)

The reasons that led us to these proposals are the following:




b. With fresh memories of the issue of participation of the 6 or 7 top teams of the European Championship which qualify directly in Deaflympics Games (Proposal of Italian Sport Federation of the Deaf in 2007, Salt Lake USA), where a confusion created in many countries) .
2. There is an appearance of withdrawal participation of countries that have direct qualification for the World Deaf Football Championships and Deaflympics Games.
3. Equal opportunities for all national teams.
4. Nomination of competitive teams.

We propose:

1. The qualifiers for the European Championship as it are.
2. The participation of a country in the World Championships or the participation of a country in the Deaflympics Games would be based on the Qualifying and would be organized only by ICSD.
EDSO will organize qualifiers ONLY for the European Deaf Championships.
3. To applied faithfully the games rules, that FIFA define.
4. ICSD had defined that during the games, in case an athlete wear an acoustic device, then his team loses with a 3-0 score in football and 20-0 in basketball, REPLACEMENT. An athlete who is wearing an acoustic device is expelled from the tournament and the game continues normally.
5. EDSO should bring audiologic machine athlete examination, that in case of a protest, have a directly examination.(please proceed in a buy in case that you not have)

In accordance with the Article 8.02 of the Constitution applications concerning the Statutes and Regulations and questions should be submitted in writing and in English)

National Deaf Sports Federation should not less than for three months to inform EDSO on the invitation of foreign teams when will organize the international tournaments, friendship games on sports. National Deaf Sports Federation should pay fee 15 euro for each invited team. If the notice has arrived later, i.e. less than for three months, the payment doubles. If the notice has arrived after tournament carrying out, the payment is brought in the fivefold size. Byelorussian Deaf Sports Federation makes the proposal to establish term for the notice to the EDSO: one month and to establish registration fee for each invited team only in the unitary size. Need exclude double or fivefold size of registration fees to the EDSO if the National Deaf Sports Federation independently organizes tournament.

Explanation:

Holding tournament or friendship games during global economic crisis depends on finance which is allocated to clubs, to federations by Governments, or other sponsors, and the decision on assignment often is accepted in other minimum terms. Often happens that the assignment question darts literally within a month. The question and in a team which is invited to tournament is in the same way solved. Holding tournament depends on it. Reduction of terms for notice to EDSO (tournament registration in EDSO) will allow a thicket to hold various international meetings that will promote the further development and popularization of Deaf Sports. And also holding various tournaments allows to include into teams not only members of National teams for participation in tournament, but also other less qualified athletes who are interested in the sport. It will promote mass character development, and popularization of the sport and, finally, the general growth of sports skill.

In case at least five different countries or five sports clubs from five different countries are participating in a tournament to take place in Europe only 100€ authorisation fee will be collected (including men and women). In case there are less than five countries 50€ authorisation fee is collected.

Application for unitary regulations for the host of European championships fully valid for all kind of sports. The regulations of 19/20 May 1994 shall be updated respectively and the following topics shall be included:

- **cost-free transport** on site = point of arrival to & from hotel – hotel to & from competition – hotel to & from training. (see athletics indoor EC Tallin/EST).
- in case the point of arrival is far away from the competition venue, transport **costs should be restricted** to a payable amount.
- the city of the competition venue shall provide convenient **international transport access**.
- **separate specification and invoicing** of all costs, which do not belong to the competition or sports like farewell parties and trips.
- accommodation – each host is obliged to offer at least **three different price class** accommodation options.
- all above mentioned costs should be announced in due time – e.g. October of the previous year for the budgeting of the coming year and the raising of governmental funds and sponsoring.
- no country shall be awarded with the host of a championship, which does not have an own team starting in the tournament in question (see women football EC Albena/BUL).

Explanation:

Unitary regulations ensure a smooth and equal preparation for all – EDSO, hosts and participants.

- The EDSO should keep in mind that **exploding transport, accommodation and participating costs** will lead to lower chances for less affluent countries to take part in international events. Due to the critical economic situation in various countries, each country should have the chance to take part at lowest costs possible. Otherwise the development of Deaf Sports in Europe may become more and more regressive, as less and less countries may afford their participation in international sports events.
- A country which has no own team of the sports of the European championships in question may not have well-founded, organisational experience in the respective sports requirements.
