

How to submit for a European or World Record during and after the Deaflympics



European or World deaf records can only be submitted in athletics (field and track), shooting or swimming. Also for junior athletics.

The forms can be downloaded for a:

Here is what to do:

- Immediately after the event, complete your form accordingly if it is a European or World deaf record.
- The first section - 'general information' to the 'guarantee by referee' - must be filled in by the referee and the coach.
- The referee must sign as the guarantee.
- The athlete and/or coach need to double check the 'document checklist'. Make sure you have everything listed and then scan and email everything with the form to UKDS at office@ukds.co.uk
- UKDS will check everything in order and sign the final part of the form before forwarding it all onto EDSO or ICSD for final verification by the sport technical director.
- If it is a European deaf record, EDSO will check everything and update their website accordingly. Unfortunately, EDSO do not inform UKDS once this has been done so we must keep checking.
- If it is a World deaf record, ICSD will check everything and update their website accordingly. ICSD will also send a certificate in the post directly to UKDS which will then be forwarded to the deaf athlete who is the owner of the new World Record.
- All forms need to be completed as soon as possible after the event within a month by the athlete and/or coach.
